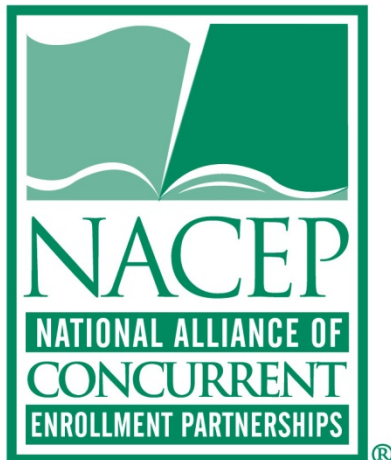

NACEP efforts resulted in Dual and Concurrent Enrollment specifically promoted as a vehicle for college readiness and success in:

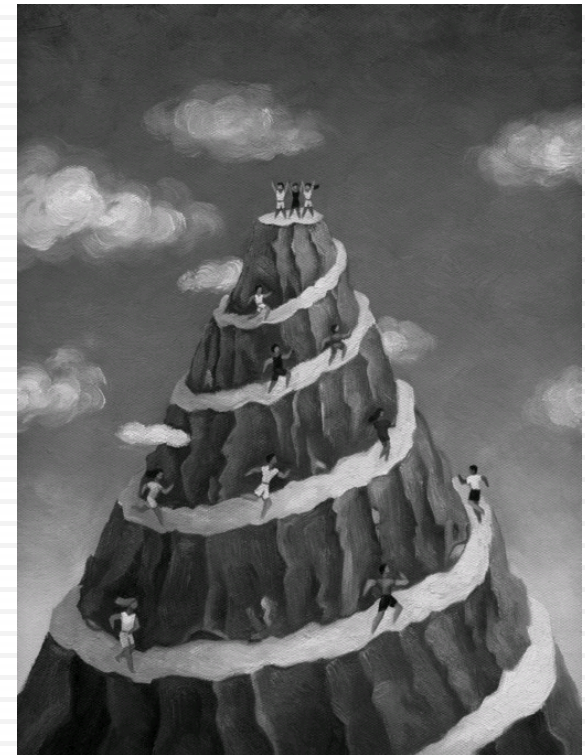
