JCCC

Credit

- 21,033 students
- 175,394 credit hours
- 34 high schools in the county

College Now

- 3010 students
 - 14.31%
- 17,118 credit hours
 - 9.78%
- 26 high schools participate



Johnson County Demographics

- 18% of Kansas' population
- 38% of Kansas' income
- Per capita income = \$43,327 – top 2%
- Median income = \$63,155
- 95% over 25 have HS diploma – 1st in US
- 48% have BA/BS – 6th in US
- 16% have grad degree – 16th in US



Givens

- State requires principal's authorization to “apply for enrollment”
- Sophomores through seniors eligible
 - Freshmen must be gifted
- State limits number of credit hours to 24
- Instructor qualifications equal to on-campus courses
- State reporting day is 20th day of semester
 - Usually 4-5 weeks after start of HS semester
- Classes not uniquely identified on transcript
 - State and NACEP require concurrent enrollment
 - Students be treated as equals to on-campus students

Why push to student accountability

- Enrollment forms illegible
- Mad rush at deadline caused major overtime
- Staff had to call many who were missing something (test score, pre-req, etc.)
- Many times forms and payment arrived separately and had to be matched
- Students do not realize they are enrolling in college
- “Nobody told me”

- Buy-in from registration, business office, and high school counselors
- One-and-done authorization form
- Step-by-step site – www.jccc.edu/collegenow
- Courses built in special Part of Term in Banner
- Established Banner workflow to hold student account when 24 CN hours reached

College Now Admissions and Enrollment Process



COLLEGE NOW INSTRUCTIONS AND IMPORTANT DATES

College Now is a concurrent credit program, so your high school enrollment stands separate from your JCCC enrollment.

You must complete all five of the enrollment steps listed below and explained in more detail at www.jccc.edu/collegenow.

8-30-12	Application, authorization form and ACT/SAT test score priority submission deadline. Forms will be accepted after this deadline, but there is no guarantee of processing by the enrollment deadline	8-30-12

9-14-12	Enrollment deadline (payment is due at the time of enrollment, see step 5)	9-14-12
9-17-12	Last day for 100% refund	9-28-12

- ❑ **Step 1 – Complete and Return High School Authorization Form** – see high school counselor for a copy –this form only needs to be completed once, regardless of the number of semesters you participate in College Now and/or Quick Step. Return this form to JCCC Admissions, NOT to your high school counselor.
- ❑ **Step 2 – Complete Application for Admission** – www.jccc.edu/creditapplication - complete this form once, regardless of the number of semesters you participate in College Now and/or Quick Step.
- ❑ **Step 3 – Submit Placement Test Scores** – see the College Now schedule for your school to determine if placement scores are required.

Placement Information: All placement tests (COMPASS) will be administered on a computer in the Testing Center on the third floor of the Student Center. The test is given on a walk-in basis; no appointment is necessary. The average test time for the complete battery of COMPASS is approximately two hours. Individual tests average about an hour. A current photo ID and JCCC ID number are **required** to test. Check this website – www.jccc.edu/testing - for study guides and Testing Lab hours.

Placement Tests must be started one hour prior to lab closing.
