- **OADEP Report - Becky Harr**
 - Senate Bill 104
 - SB 104 was brought about by the performance audit from the State Auditor's office.
 - The auditor's office is open to feedback on the bill.
 - OADEP will work to have a voice on the various 104 issues as long as we have strong consensus on an issue. If the membership is divided on an issue the members should look to their specific institutional associations to have their voice heard.
 - OADEP members can email their thoughts on SB 104 to Rob Callahan, our Government Relations Chair.
 - Much discussion was had over SB 104. Not limited to but including.
 - Expanding access to multiple year application process.
 - Textbooks being required to be OER or funding will be varied.
 - Teacher credentialing changing and moving CCP backwards
 - More requirements/ hoops will be hurting participation by creating more barriers. This will especially impact underrepresented students.
 - Code vs Law would give more flexibility to work through these new proposals.
 - There is a good article in [Inside Higher Ed](#) by Matt Reed on CCP vs AP. Tom Wolford talks about this on his twitter feed.
 - The compliance survey and school audits
 - Much of the information the survey wanted is not typical data that is collected.
 - The Dashboard is not an accurate tool.
