The Jumpstart on College Act was introduced to the House and Senate on August 1. The legislation would improve college access, increase affordability, and improve degree completion rates by expanding college-in-the-high-school programs including dual enrollment and early college high schools.

## **Relevant Research**

### **National Center for Educational Statistics**

According to the 2019 report from the National Center for Educational Statistics that examines 2009 ninth-graders who graduated from high school by fall 2013, 88.8% of schools offered dual enrollment programs. The report also contains information about AP and IB credit.

- 91.7% of public schools offered dual enrollment programs
- 54.3% of private schools offered dual enrollment programs
- 91.1% of schools in the Midwest offered dual enrollment programs
